What kinds of impact may they have on existing narratives? What are their potentials and limitations? And how might they be used to engage with and expand target audiences?

Following the conference, Polin Museum of the history of Polish Jews and The HL-Center, The Norwegian Center for Holocaust and Minority Studies, will publish the accepted conference papers along with key findings and highlights.
